Aryabhata is also known as the father of Indian Mathematics who significantly contributed to mathematics and astronomy and discovered theories like solar system rotation, approximation of π , trigonometry, place value system and zero, and many others.



Subhas Chandra Bose is called Netaji Subash Chandra Bose - He is famous for his role as a leader in the Indian independence movement, known for forming the Indian National Army (INA) and his assertive, militaristic approach to fighting British rule. His famous slogan, "Give me blood, and I will give you freedom,"



Rabindranath Tagore is famous for being the first non-European to win the Nobel Prize in Literature (1913) for his collection of poems, Gitanjali. Tagore is also celebrated for composing the national anthems for both India and Bangladesh.



Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam was an Indian scientist and the 11th President of India, known as the "Missile Man of India" for his work on missile and nuclear weapons programs. Born in Rameswaram, He received the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian award. He was known for his humility and vision, and for inspiring millions, especially students, to dream big and work hard.
